- 6 START AND FINISH
Modify first sentence as follows:-
The event will start in the Main Car Park, Park Avenue, Aberystwyth.
- 7 Delete "Six figure Grid Reference"
Substitute "Eight figure Grid Reference"
- 9 (D) OTHER AWARDS
Add Caprice Restaurant/Four Seasons Hotel Man of the Rally Award. This to be determined by panel of Press Representatives.
To the best W.S.S.C.C. Limited crew a further Award presented by A.T. Arnold Steel Stockholders Limited.
- 10 ENTRIES
Competitors should note that there will not be a levy imposed to cover increased Forestry Commission road charges.
A list of competitors actual start times from MC 1 will be issued at the drivers briefing in the Kings Hall at 2300 hrs. 10th October 1980.
Car No. 1 will start at 0801 hrs. but the entry list will be closed up taking into account all non-starters.
It is the competitors responsibility to know his correct start time. Penalties under ASR 19A(2) will be strictly enforced.
Time cards will be issued to competitors at M.C.1.
- 11 CONTROLS AND TIMING
Sub-paragraph D - Special Stage Finish
Competitors should note that two special stages will have separate departure controls and timing for the following road sections will be from these and not stage finishes.
- 14 SERVICING

- 18 SCRUTINEERING AND SIGNING ON
Details of Scrutineering and Signing On are as follows:-
Scrutineering will take place at Charles Clark Aberystwyth Limited, Park Avenue, Aberystwyth.

Competitors will report for scrutineering during the following periods:-

There will be no scrutineering on Saturday morning.

Competitors unable to comply with the above timetable and reserves should contact Michael Wood (Secretary of the Event) for an alternative appointment.

On arriving at the Start Area competitors should follow the instructions of the marshalls and report first to the Noise Check, followed by Scrutineering and then proceed to the Main Car Park where cars will be placed in Parc Ferme. Competitors will then proceed to Signing On at Rally Headquarters (The Belle Vue Royal Hotel). The Start Card will be issued at Noise Check and must be produced at each stage of the proceedings and when fully completed will be exchanged at signing on, for a Road Book.

10 minutes are allowed between leaving the Scrutineering Area and reporting to Parc Ferme (See Final Instructions Para 19).

Competitors attention is drawn to the maximum permitted Noise Level which is 84 dbA.

Competitors will be required to produce proof of Insurance Cover at signing on.
