1. Timetable of the Rally

Scrutineering Friday 16th October, 16.00 - 22.00 hrs.

Documentation Friday 16th October, 16.00 - 22.00 hrs.

Rally finishes Saturday 17th October 16.30 hrs.

4. R.A.C. Permit No. RAL. 1710/6  
DOT Authorisation No. TBA.

6. Start and Finish of event at the Municipal Car Park, Park Avenue, Aberystwyth.

Car 1 will start at 08.00 hrs. Saturday 17th October.  
Cars will start at 1 minute intervals.

There is a Parc Ferme between scrutineering and the start. There are 36 road and 30 stage miles to Service A.

There will be a convoy of highest placed overall competitors, class winners, championship winners etc., from MC4 to the Promenade for a publicity finish. Crews involved will be informed at MC1+. All competitors co-operation is requested in this matter.

Any vehicles selected for post event scrutineering will also be indicated at MC4.

A car wash has been arranged after the last special stage - please use this facility.

## 9. Awards

## 11. Controls and Timing

A revised list of start times will be posted on the official rally notice board after signing on (this will take into account non starters as the entry will be 'closed up').

It is the competitor's responsibility to acquaint themselves with their correct start time.

Time cards will be issued to competitors at MC1.

Maximum lateness between main controls will be 20 minutes.

There will be a main control at the start of each service area. These controls will be used to cancel all lateness for competitors arriving within their maximum lateness, as A.S.R. 11(a)1V. Competitors may leave main controls 2 and 3 on their due arrival time.

The subsequent service area will have a target time and will be marked as a road section.

The out control from each service area will be an S.V. control and function as a time control only.

This is a modification to S.R.11.

#### 18. Scrutineering and Signing On

Scrutineering will take place at Charles Clark Limited, Park Avenue, Aberystwyth.

Competitors should report as follows:

Numbers	1 - 30	16.00 - 17.00 hrs.
	31 - 60	17.00 - 18.00 hrs.
	61 - 90	18.00 - 19.00 hrs.
	91 - 120	19.00 - 20.00 hrs.

There will be no scrutineering on Saturday morning.

Competitors unable to comply with the above timetable should contact the Secretary of the Meeting prior to commencement of scrutineering for an alternative time.

On arrival at the scrutineering area competitors should report to the noise check where their scrutineering card will be issued. The competitors should then be scrutineered and will then be directed into Parc Ferme in the main car park : time allowed 10 minutes.

Competitors should then sign on at the Belle Vue Royal Hotel. The completed scrutineering card will be required.

Rally numbers will be available at the start.

The Secretary of the Meeting will be available at Rally Headquarters from 9.00 hrs. Friday 10th October. Aberystwyth 617558.
