FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PARAGRAPH No:-

6. CONTROLS AND TIMING.

Main controls will be situated at the start and finish of the Rally only. Maximum permitted lateness between main controls will be 15 minutes.

Time cards will be issued to all competitors at the assembly area in the Shirehall car park, Shrewsbury, immediately prior to the start.

9. SERVICING.

Please make use of the car wash facilities provided by The Andrews Group Hire Centre which will be in the service area.

10. IDENTIFICATION.

Competition numbers will be on sale at the Shirehall assembly area.

11. DAMAGE DECLARATION.

Damage Declarations must be returned within 48 hours of the event in accordance with L4.13.2.

12. JUDGES OF FACT

Judges of fact for noise, servicing, pace notes and driving standards will be listed on the official notice board at signing on.

The Driving Standards Observer will be Jack Romain.

The Noise Test Official will be Kevin Page.

13. SCRUTINEERING AND SIGNING ON.

Scrutineering will take place in two sessions as follows:-

1. Friday 18th October - 18.00 hours to 22.00 hours.

2. Saturday 19th October - 08.00 hours to 09.00 hours.

SESSION 2 ON SATURDAY MORNING WILL BE BY PRIOR ARRANGEMENT ONLY.

On arrival in Shrewsbury competitors must first report to the Noise Check at The Shirehall (Map ref.- 126/506122 - see attached plan) where a scrutineering card will be issued. Cars will then be despatched to scrutineering by the marshals. Due to the limited amount of space available only a small number of cars will be sent to scrutineering at any one time.

After scrutineering, competitors must take their completed scrutineering card to signing-on. On Friday night this will be held at The Beauchamp Hotel, The Mount, Shrewsbury (Map ref. - 126/478132 - Tel.0743 3230). On Saturday morning signing-on will take place in the Shell caravan at the Shirehall assembly area.

13. SCRUTINEERING AND SIGNING ON (continued)

The Entries Secretary will be available at The Beauchamp Hotel (0743 3230) from 10.30 hours on Friday 18th October.

Competitors are respectfully asked to avoid The Radbrook Hall Hotel on Friday 18th October as a large private function is being held there and we are unable to use the facilities at this hotel until Saturday 19th October. Your co-operation in this matter will be much appreciated.

21. START AND FINISH.

The Rally will start at The Shirehall, Shrewsbury (map reference 126/509122) at 09.00 hours on Saturday 19th October.

Competitors must report to The Shirehall (see attached plan) at least 20 minutes before their provisional start time. Time cards, giving competitors actual start times, will be issued at this point. Any gaps which may arise in the entry list due to non-starters will be closed up. The first car will leave MC1 at 09.00 hours and subsequent vehicles will follow at one minute intervals.

There will be a convoy of highest placed overall competitors and other award winners for a publicity finish. Crews involved will be informed at PCE.

After the finish (MC2) there will be a parc ferme where vehicles for post event scrutineering will be notified. No vehicle may be removed from this parc ferme until authorised by the Clerk of the Course.

22. ROUTE.

All stages will be on loose surfaces. Maps 124, 125, 126 and 135 will be required. Please note that map 135 is an addition to those published in the Supplementary Regulations and competitors are recommended to use the 1985 edition of map 126.

There are 65 road miles and 13 stage miles between the start (MC1) and the first service area.

23. AWARDS PRESENTATION.

Awards will be presented at 21.30 hours on Saturday 19th October in the Ballroom of the Radbrook Hall Hotel, Radbrook Road, Shrewsbury. Competitors are reminded to note the penultimate paragraph in Section 23 (Awards) of the Supplementary Regulations. The first two rows of seats in the Ballroom will be reserved for award winners in order to expedite the proceedings. Competitors co-operation in making use of this facility will be appreciated.

27. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.

Due to the restricted car parking in Shrewsbury, space is available for the parking of rally cars and trailers at The Shirehall car park on Friday 18th October. This is not a parc ferme and cars will be parked at owners risk. However, there will be representatives from a security company present throughout the night.

Please drive carefully and quietly in Shrewsbury at all times.
