SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATION No:-Art.6 IDENTIFICATION.

Competition numbers will be provided at scrutineering.

Art.11 DAMAGE DECLARATION.

Damage declarations must be returned within 48 hours of the event in accordance with L4.13.2.

Art.12 JUDGES OF FACT

Judges of fact for noise, servicing, pace notes and driving standards will be listed on the official notice board at signing on.

Art.10 SCRUTINEERING AND SIGNING ON.

Scrutineering will take place in two sessions as follows:-

- 1. Friday 10th October 17.00 hours to 21.30 hours.
- 2. Saturday 11th October 07.30 hours to 08.30 hours.

SESSION 2 ON SATURDAY MORNING WILL BE BY PRIOR ARRANGEMENT ONLY.

On arrival in Shrewsbury competitors must first report to the Noise Check at The Shirehall (Map ref.-126/506122 - see attached plan) where a scrutineering card will be issued. Cars will then be despatched to scrutineering by the marshals. Due to the limited amount of space available only a small number of cars will be sent to scrutineering at any one time.

After scrutineering competitors must take their completed scrutineering card to signing-on. On Friday night this will be held at The Radbrook Hall Hotel, Radbrook Road, Shrewsbury (Map ref. - 126/473119 - Te1.0743 64956). On Saturday morning signing-on will take place in Shrewsbury Motors, English Bridge, Shrewsbury.

The Entries Secretary will be available at the Radbrook Hall Hotel from 10.30 hours on Friday 10th October.

# Art.13 CONTROLS AND TIMING.

Main controls will be situated at the start and finish of the Rally only. Maximum permitted lateness between main controls will be 15 minutes.

Time cards will be issued to all competitors at the assembly area in Loton Park immediately prior to the start.

#### Art.21 START AND FINISH.

The Rally will start at Loton Park, Alderbury, Shrewsbury (map reference 126/357143) at 08.55 hours on Saturday 11th October.

Competitors must report to the start at least 20 minutes before their provisional start time. Time cards, giving competitors actual start times, will be issued at this point. Any gaps which may arise in the entry list due to non-starters will be closed up. The first car will leave MC1 at 08.55 hours and subsequent vehicles will follow at one minute intervals.

There will be a convoy of highest placed overall competitors and other award winners for a publicity finish. Crews involved will be informed at MC2.

After the finish (MC2) there will be a parc ferme where vehicles for post event scrutineering will be notified. No vehicle may be removed from this parc ferme until authorised by the Clerk of the Course.

NOTE:- At MC2 the area of car park in front of the main Radbrook College building will be locked from 20.45hrs. on Saturday.

ALL CARS MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE THIS TIME.

The remainder of the College area is available for car parking throughout the evening.

#### Art.22 ROUTE.

Maps 124, 125, 126 and 135, series 2 will be required. Please note that map 135 is an addition to those published in the Supplementary Regulations.

There are 3 road miles and 2 stage miles between the start (MC1) and the first service area.

All stages will be on unsealed roads, except for one venue, used twice, of mixed surfaces. (0.5 miles asphalt, 2 miles unsealed)

## Art.23 AWARDS.

Awards will be presented at 22.00 hours on Saturday 11th October in the Ballroom of the Radbrook Hall Hotel, Radbrook Road, Shrewsbury. Competitors are asked to note the penultimate paragraph in Art.23 (Awards) of the Supplementary Regulations. The first two rows of seats it: the Ballroom will be reserved for award winners in o,der to e:Tedite the proceedings. Competitors co-operation in making use of this facility will he appreciated.

# Art.24 ENTRIES

The maximum number of entries for the Event has been increased from 125 to 130.
