Art.6 IDENTIFICATION.

Competition numbers will be provided at scrutineering.

Art.10 SCRUTINEERING AND SIGNING ON.

ON ARRIVAL IN TELFORD competitors should leave service vehicles and trailers at Rally Headquarters or other safe location as only competing cars will be welcome at the noise check and scrutineering.

Competitors travelling to the noise check should note the CLOSURE of the A442 QUEENSWAY north of The Hollingsgate Roundabout, and hence should use the alternative route of the A5 and B5061 to the Greyhound Interchange. NOISE CHECK at The British Telecom Sports and Social Club, Trench Lock 3, Telford (127/684123 - see attached plan) where a scrutineering card will be issued.

Cars should then proceed to scrutineering.

SCRUTINEERING will take place at Hardy's of Telford (127/699133 - see plan) on Friday 23rd October - 17.00 hours to 22.00 hours. After scrutineering competitors must take their completed scrutineering card to signing-on.

Art.12 JUDGES OF FACT

Judges of fact for noise, servicing, pace notes and driving standards will be listed on the official notice board at signing on. The driving standards observer is Jack Romain.

The RAC MSA points out that any cases of speeding, reckless driving or failing to observe road signs reported by the Police will automatically be considered as a possible contravention of rule M.1.1.4. and the competitor concerned will be liable to be called before a Disciplinary Tribunal.

Art.13 CONTROLS AND TIMING.

Main controls will be situated at the start and finish of the Rally only. Maximum permitted lateness between main controls will be 15 minutes.

Time cards will be issued to all competitors at the assembly area at The Cann Office Hotel immediately prior to MC1.

Art.15 SERVICING.

Only vehicles with the appropriate plates, properly affixed, will be permitted into the service areas by marshals.

No trade vehicles will be allowed into service area A & C.

Art.21 START AND FINISH.

The Rally will start at The CANN OFFICE HOTEL, LLANGADFAN (125/012107) at 08.30 hours on Saturday 24th October.

Competitors must report to the start at least 15 minutes before their provisional start time. Time cards, giving competitors actual start times, will be issued at this point. Any gaps which may arise in the entry list due to non-starters will be closed up. The first car will leave MCl at 08.30 hours and subsequent vehicles will follow at one minute intervals.

There will be a convoy of highest placed overall competitors and other award winners for a publicity finish. Crews involved will be informed at SSF12.

After the finish (MC2) there will be a parc ferme where vehicles for post event scrutineering will be notified. No vehicle may be removed from this parc ferme until authorised by the Clerk of the Course.

Art.22 ROUTE.

Maps 124, 125, 126, 127 and 135 will be required.

There are 18 road miles and 11 stage miles between the start (MCl) and the first service area.

All stages will be on unsealed roads, except for the Telford Town Park Stage at the end of the Event. This stage is used twice at 30 second intervals and is all tarmac. This stage (1.3 miles in length) may be inspected ON FOOT prior to the Event start. A map is enclosed showing the route through the park. VEHICLES MAY NOT ENTER THE PARK but adequate parking is available and pedestrian access is unrestricted.




