- C. Exclusion From The Event
- 1. The whole length of the Rally will be one leg or section. (i.e. There will only be one period of 30 minutes total lateness throughout the Rally)

Control TC10b will be the designated control referred to in Article 17.C.1 after the finish of the last stage. Hence for road section RS:10b, between TC10b and TC10c there will be no penalty free lateness. 




