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## FORWARD

## SAFETY

At least one ambulance, one doctor and one recovery vehicle are available on all stages.

Radio communication equipment is sited at all stage starts and finishes as well as points indicated along the route through the forest.

Should you be forced to stop for any reason on a special stage you must display your 'OK' board to following competitors or if, and only if, you require immediate medical assistance you should display your 'SOS' board. Try and make your competition number visible to following cars. Put out your RED TRIANGLE to warn competitors and protect your own car.

When you come across a competitor stopped on a stage confirm that human life is not in danger and that an SOS is not being shown. Note the location of the car in relation to the numbered junctions and its competition number and report the facts to the marshals at the stage finish.

Remember that it may be you who next require assistance.
The Organisers will attempt to link 'lost' crews with their service personnel with the help of the safety radio network if practicable when the relevant stage has closed.

A recovery vehicle will pass through each special stage to extricate competitors from immediate difficulties after the stage has been shut by the course closing car.

Stage 4 will not be cleared until final closure after being reused as stage 7.

## HAZARDS

Certain Fire-Breaks and other known hazards will be numbered as junctions in the Road Book and arrowed on the stage.

As the hazards due to logs in the forest are changing day by day they may not be marked in the road book. Any hazards that are found on the day prior to the event will be the subject of a competitors information sheet. Also, the marshals at stage starts will inform competitors of particularly dangerous locations and these will be indicated by exclamation marks on the stages.

## Petrol

Garages with petrol available along the route of the rally have been noted in the Road Book.
An analysis of rally mileages is given in the servicing information.

## Other Information

If you retire, please inform Rally Headquarters at the TELFORD MOAT HOUSE HOTEL (0952 291291) as soon as possible. You must submit your damage declaration to the organisers, via the nearest time control convenient, or at Rally HQ.

There is a results query form at the rear of this book.
A record sheet for you to keep a check on other competitors times is also at the rear of the book.

## STAGE ARROWING SYSTEM

Positioning of Arrows at JUNCTIONS in conjunction with 'No Entry' Boards.
It should be noted that the gate formed by two arrows is always set immediately before the junction on the approach road and to avoid ambiguity, where necessary, the angle of directional change will be exaggerated. Incorrect roads will have 'No Entry' boards and will be blocked but not necessarily at the junction. The junction number (indicated in the road book) will be fixed to the warning arrow.


## PROCEDURE AT CONTROLS

## THE START

The procedure at controls will be as described in section $V$ of the Regulations. Control boards are shown in Appendix $I$ of the regulations

Competitors MUST report to the Assembly Area in the Back Lane Public Car Park in Newtown (map ref. 136/106917), prior to TC0, 20 minutes before their due start time.

At TCO competitors will be dispatched at one minute intervals, the first car's due departure time being 08.00 hours 19th October 1991.

Maximum lateness on the event is 30 minutes, of which 15 minutes is penalty free.

## FINISH

There will be a regrouping control between the last stage and the finish control. During the regrouping cars will pass over a finishers ramp for a 'publicity' finish. On leaving the regrouping control the competitors will proceed to the final control of the event at the entrance to Parc Ferme.

Cars must remain in the Parc Ferme until the results are declared final. This will not be before 19.45 hours on the 19 th October.

Vehicles required for post event scrutiny will be informed at the final control. These vehicles must proceed immediately to the scrutineering venue escorted by a representative of the organisers. A representative of the competitor and also his/her mechanics will be required to attend but not necessarily the competing crew.

Should any crew wish to remove their vehicle from the Parc Ferme before the declaration of final results, the request form at the rear of this road book should be completed and handed to the Clerk of the Course for his authorisation.

The results of the event will be on display on the official notice board in the Moat House Hotel.

## INTRODUCTION TO 'TULIP' ROAD BOOK

The Road book describes the route for the whole rally, including Special Stages, by 'tulip' diagrams.
Junctions on road sections where the route is obvious have not been included on the 'tulip'. Competitors should simply continue on the road on which they are travelling.
The names quoted as appearing on a signpost were those present at the time of survey and cannot be guaranteed.

All speed limits and 'Give Way' junctions have been shown. Please observe them, as the Police know you are coming.

Please drive carefully and quietly on Public roads, especially near to forests as they are narrow and there are local residents who will be using them.

Tulips have been provided for the journey from Telford to Newtown, although it is not part of the actual rally route. Nine miles after Welshpool there is a measured mile for competitors wishing to check their trip against the one used when making the road book.
On Special Stages the advanced warning arrow on each hazard or junction will bear the same number as the corresponding 'tulip' in the road book.
