FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Article 3 - Authorisation

Permit number 40936 has been issued.

DOT Authorisation Number will be displayed on the official notice board.

Article 5 - Format

Add Taliesin to the list of forests used.

See attached route by map reference.

Article 7 - Identification

On behalf of the Welsh Association of Motor Clubs competitors are requested to carry an extra competition number throughout the event. This is part of a trial which if successful is likely to be tried out on a wider scale in Wales in 1996.

The sole aim in developing this idea is to improve the safety of competitors. Numbers that are easy to read in adverse conditions will make it easier for marshals and radio operators to identify and keep track of cars. There may be other benefits in the longer but safety is the prime objective. All competitors will be aware that on events where weather conditions are poor the numbers on the doors quickly become unreadable. The specific location of these additional numbers will hopefully overcome these difficulties.

Location - On the event you will be provided with two additional numbered plates to those normally provided. These will be of clear plastic with six inch fluorescent numbers attached. **THE PLATES MUST BE STUCK ON THE INSIDE OF EACH REAR SIDE WINDOW OF THE VEHICLE.** It is a requirement of the event that no additional stickers or signs are placed on these windows.

There are a few cars which do not have rear side windows or they are not large enough to accommodate the plates. Exceptions will obviously have to be made for these cars.

It is hoped that competitors will appreciate the benefits to their safety by the introduction of this scheme and co-operate fully in its implementation. At the current time all usual numbering on the doors will have to continue as a requirement of the 'Blue Book' but, if as we hope, the scheme is eventually adopted by the RACMSA then it may be possible to release the front door space for other purposes - like sponsors!

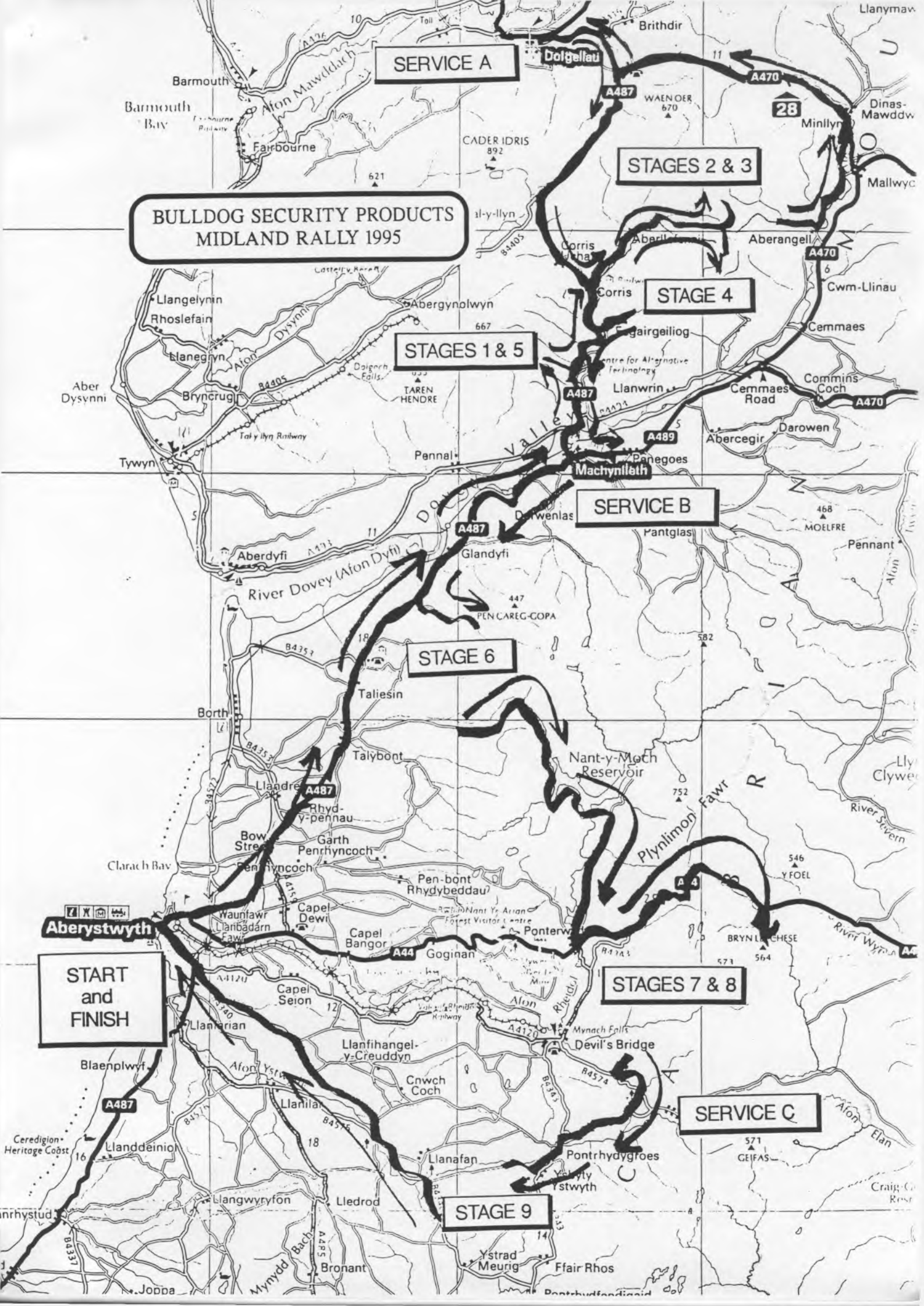

The cash awards are awarded at the end of the season for the overall performance in the Championship and are not event awards.

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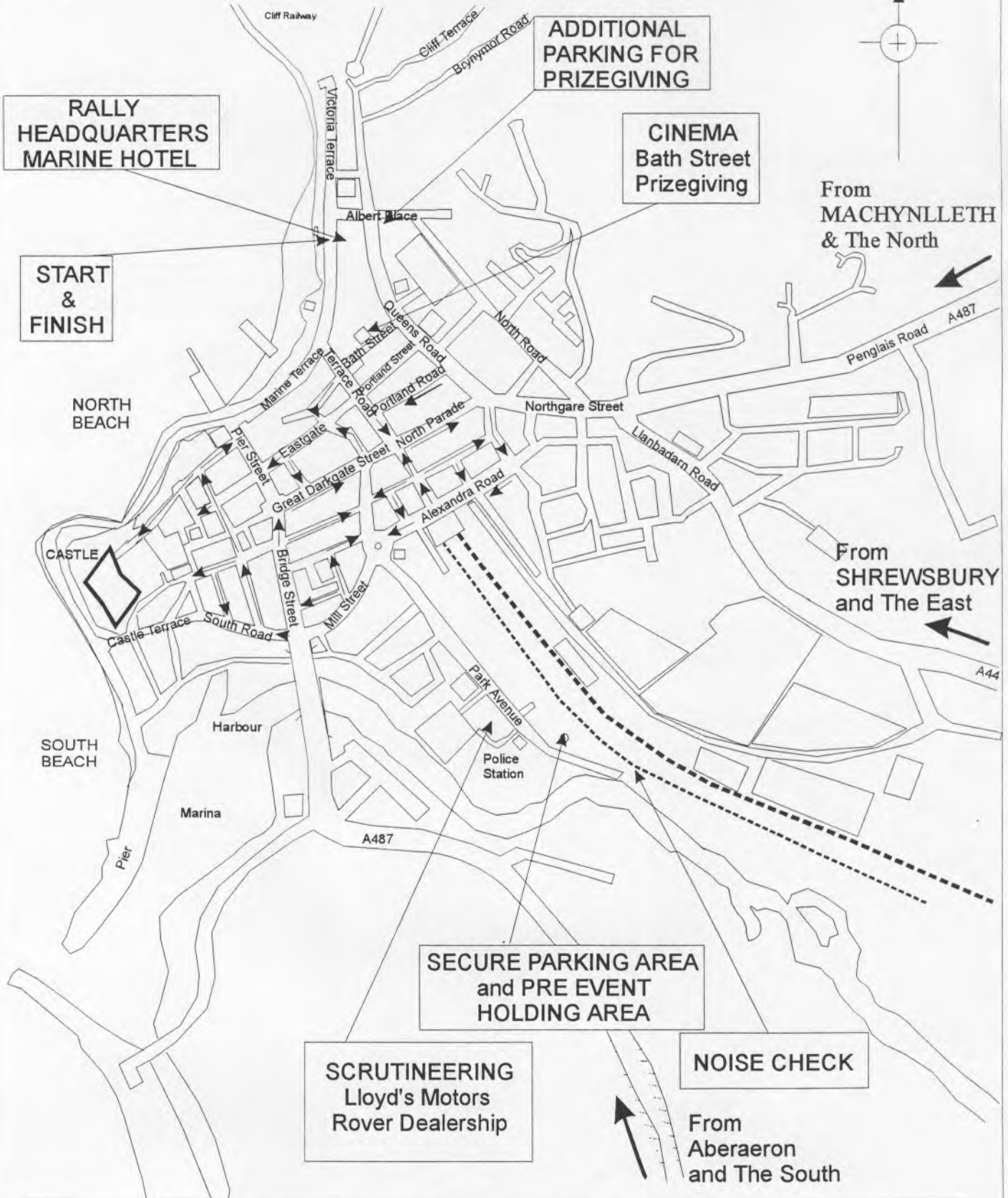

Competitors Information Bulletin No 1

Noise check

On arrival in Aberystwyth competitors should proceed to the attended parking area in Park Avenue (see attached map). After unloading the competition vehicle the trailer should be parked tidily. Competition numbers must be applied before proceeding to the noise check.

The noise check is situated adjacent to the parking area (see map)

Scrutineering

On completion of the noise check you will be presented with a process card and the vehicle should proceed to scrutineering at Lloyds Motors, Park Avenue at the scheduled time. The scrutineering schedule is attached - preference will be given to competitors who arrive at their due time - any others not on schedule will be held in reserve and allocated a time when available by the marshals.

Documentation

The vehicle should be removed from the scrutineering bay and parked in the attended area. The crew should proceed to documentation which will take place in the Service Reception area of Lloyds Motors.

Attended Parking

The organisers have arranged a parking area immediately opposite the Police Station in Park Avenue which will be attended during the hours of 22.00 and 8.00 Friday / Saturday night. Competitors should take every security precaution when leaving vehicles overnight.

Start Procedure

Competitors should assemble at the Park Avenue car park at least 20 mins prior to their due start time as displayed on the official notice board. Cars will be despatched to the start area by marshals. Time cards will be distributed as competitors arrive at Marine Terrace prior to MC1.

The organisers will have a help desk within the Marine Hotel, Marine Terrace, Aberystwyth, throughout the Rally telephone number 01970 627329

Finish

Prior to the final control on the finish ramp there will be a regrouping control and a car wash. This will be situated on the harbour side in Aberystwyth.

Results will be displayed in the Marine Hotel.

The organisers have made arrangements within the Marine Hotel for shower and changing facilities for competitors. Anyone wishing to use these facilities should contact the Help Desk in the foyer of the Marine Hotel; please bring your own towels.

There will be cafeteria style hot food as well as a full range of drinks and meals in the ballroom of the Marine Hotel.

Post event Scrutiny

Those vehicles required for post event scrutiny will be informed at the pre finish regroup control. The scrutiny will take place at Lloyd Motors Park Avenue.

Prizegiving

Prizegiving will take place at The Cinema in Bath Street Aberystwyth. The organisers have arranged for additional parking to be available on the North Road Clinic Car Park (see map).
