As competitors on the AUDI SPORT NATIONAL RALLY pulled into the halfway Service Halt at Machnellath, Soota erex Ken Wood and Peter Brown hald a tenuous 2 second lead. Their Golder Wonder Metro 68% just holding off the similar car of Pat Doran/Steve Harvey. The Hally is being dominated by the ubiquitous Metros with mis in the top 7 places. Champtonship leader David Gillanders was in a challenging third place, but naeds to win the event outright to ensure winning the series. Time Salonen/ Seppo Harjanne break the Metro sonopoly, holding fourth place after a cautious start. He is followed by a trio of Metros, Bill Barton/ Don George being closely Followed by Grant Shand/Frank Richer and Reger Clark/John Robinson. In a tight Group & battle, TrevorSmith/Roger Jones land arch rivals Russel Brookes/Neil Wilson by 9 acconds, so a flarce battle is on the cards over the closing Stages.

David Villiams/Wayne Gobje (Metro 68%) collected a puncture on the first stage but still managed to set 7th fastest time,

Championship contenders Jan and Paule Churchill were slowed on the First stage when the cockpit of their Porche filled with fumes. They re-sited the breather pipe which seemed to cure the problem. They also reported an "inconsistent" brake pedal.

Mark Levell's problems continued when the intercom failed on the first stage. The crow were preparing to change the complete front suspension at the first service balt.

Early Rally landers, Steve Whiteford/Dave Adams crashed their Hetro 684 on a bad band on Stage 3. They regained the road but subsequently spun on Stage 4, and are reporting alsoing in Stage 5.

Competitors 26 and 27 Full Dyss/Judith Flavell and Richard/Peter York are reported to have gone off on Stage 2 with the Inrk's Escort ending up on top of the Cosworth of Dyss/Flavell.

Pat Doran/Steve Harvey are experiencing gearbox problems in their Helro 6RV but were holding 2nd place after Stage 5.
