The AUDI SPORT RALLY is nicely poised after 8 of the 12 stages with longtime leader Ken Wood defending a narrow two second lead ahead of Pat Doran and David Gillanders who have hounded him all day, all three driving Metro 6R4's. Finnish ace Timo Salonen holds fourth place despite a shock absorber problem, but insists he is merely out on a testing session. Trevor Smith still leads the Championship Group A category despite a spin on SS6 and has extended his lead over Russell Brookes to 16 seconds.

Mark Lovell has changed the rear diff on his Sierra Cosworth at Dynan Service Halt and he is lying in 10th place.

Pat Doran changed the gearbox of his Metro 6R4 at Dynan Services.

Veteran rally ace Roger Clark spun on Stage 9 and damaged a rear wheel on his S.M.C. Metro 6R4. The wheel hanging at 90 degrees to the car, he lost 1 minute on the stage and a further 8 minutes in service repairing the damage.
