#### FOREWORD

It is regretted that our experiment of setting a cheaper entry fee in an attempt to encourage more entries has failed. Thanks to increased support from our sponsors however, we are pleased to report that we have been able to set the maximum standard rate entry fee at £130.00. We trust that competitors will realise the need for this and also appreciate that this fee represents extremely good value for money, as there has been no reduction in planned stage mileage or standards of organisation.

We should be grateful if, after scrutineering, all competitors would first report to the financial desk in the signing-on area before proceeding to sign on.

### PARAGRAPH

6. CONTROLS AND TIMING. Main controls will be situated only at the start and the finish of the Rally. Maximum permitted lateness between the start and the finish will be 15 minutes.

Time cards will be issued to all competitors at the Park Avenue assembly area immediately prior to the start (see Paragraph 21).

- 9. SERVICING. Please make use of the car wash facility provided by the Andrews Group Hire Centre which will be at each service area.
- 11. <u>DAMAGE DECLARATION.</u> Damage Declarations must be returned within 48 hours of the event in accordance with L4.13.2.
- 12. <u>JUDGES OF FACT</u> for noise, illegal servicing and pace notes will be nominated on the official notice board at signing on.

- 13. <u>SCRUTINEERING AND SIGNING ON.</u> Scrutineering will take place at Meirion Motors Ltd, Park Avenue, Aberystwyth in two sessions:-
  - 1. Friday 19th October- 17.00 hours to 20.30 hours
  - 2. Saturday 20th October 08.00 hours to 09.00 hours

SESSION 2 ON SATURDAY MORNING WILL BE BY PRIOR ARRANGEMENT ONLY.

On arrival in Aberystwyth, competitors should first report to the noise check (see attached plan) where a scrutineering card will be issued and then proceed to scrutineering as directed by the marshals.

Competition numbers will be available at scrutineering.

After scrutineering, competitors should take their completed scrutineering card to signing on. On Friday night this will be held at Rally Headquarters, The Belle Vue Royal Hotel, Marine Terrace, Aberystwyth (0970-617558). On Saturday morning signing on will take place within Meirion Motors Ltd, Park Avenue, Aberystwyth.

The Secretary of the Meeting will be available at Rally Headquarters (0970-617558) from 09.30 hours, Friday 19th October.

21. START AND FINISH. The Rally will start and finish on the Promenade, Marine Terrace, Aberystwyth (map reference 135/583819).

Competitors must report to the assembly area, Park Avenue, Aberystwyth at least 30 minutes before their provisional start time. Time cards giving competitors actual start times will be issued at this point. '

Any gaps which may arise in the entry list due to non-starters will be closed up. Cars will be released from this point 15 minutes before their actual start time which allows ample time for them to arrive at MC1 on the Promenade. The first car will leave MC1 at 09.15 hours, Saturday 20th October.

There will be a convoy of highest placed overall competitors and other award winners from SV6 to MC2 on the Promenade for a publicity finish. Crews involved will be informed at SV6.

After the finish (MC2) there will be a parc ferme where vehicles for post event scrutineering will be notified. No vehicle may be removed from this parc ferme until authorised by the Clerk of the Course.

22. ROUTE. All stages will be on loose surface.

Maps 124, 125 and 135 only will be required. N.B. Competitors are recommended to use the 1980 edition of Map 125.

There are 31 road miles and 29 stage miles between the start (MC1) and the first service area.
